Share Buy Back Information

Since March 1995, the Board of Directors has authorized the repurchase of Common Stock in the open market when the shares trade at a discount to net asset value of at least 8%. Through September 30, 2025, the Company has repurchased a total of 33.7 million shares of Common Stock at a total cost of \$1.1 billion. During the nine months ended September 30, 2025, 252,180 shares of Common Stock were repurchased at a cost of \$13,545,059, a discount of 12.5% to net asset value.


